The Nine Core Values

1. **Honesty** – Golf is unique from other sports in that players regularly call penalties on themselves.
2. **Integrity** – Personal honesty and independence. Golf is a game of honesty, etiquette and composure. You are responsible for your actions and personal conduct on the golf course.
3. **Sportsmanship** – Observing the rules of play and winning or losing with grace. You must know and abide by the rules of golf and be able to conduct yourself in a respectful manner.
4. **Respect** – In golf it is important to show respect for yourself, your partners, your opponents and the golf course as well as the honor and tradition of the game.
5. **Confidence** – Confidence plays a key role in the level of play that you achieve. You must have confidence in your abilities every time you play.
6. **Responsibility** – In golf, you are responsible for your actions. It is up to you to keep score, repair your divots and keep up with the pace of the play.
7. **Perseverance** – To succeed in golf, you must learn to persevere through bad breaks and your own mistakes.
8. **Courtesy** – Considerate behavior toward others. A round of golf begins and ends with a handshake and competitors are considerate to others.
9. **Judgment** – the ability to make a decision or form an opinion after consideration. Good judgment is critical in golf when deciding on strategy, club selection, when to play safe and when to take a chance as well as understanding and abiding by etiquette.
